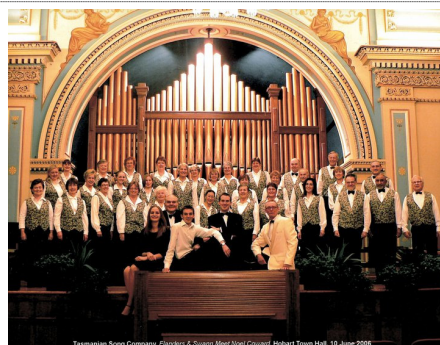

Membership and Awards

We now have the formal wording to define membership:

A member must be fully financial, as defined by Treasurer, and attend regular rehearsals and performances. This may be varied by prior agreement at the discretion of the committee. A member is entitled to vote at AGM and Special General Meetings, nominate for committee membership, wear the uniform, receive all official correspondence including “Snippets” etc and may ask for leave of absence at the discretion of the committee for illness, travel etc.

Membership is defined on a term basis as all members are requested to pay their fees within 3 weeks of the commencement of the term or to make special arrangements with the Treasurer. As there are no joining fees members are able to come and go as they wish. Non members can receive official correspondence but have no other entitlements.



And Awards:

The committee can, at any time by unanimous vote, decide to make an award of recognition to members who have by length of service, outstanding service or other provided exceptional service to the choir. The award shall be a pin or certificate and the cost should be a modest amount as approved by the treasurer. The recipient is not entitled to any special privileges other than the wearing of the pin on their uniform. Such awards will vary from time to time and are not equal to Life Membership.

This will be put forward at the next AGM so that it can be formally adopted as part of our constitution.
